

Two court locations

The Federal Magistrates Court of Australia operates from two court locations in Sydney for matters relating to general federal law:

- John Maddison Tower, levels 5, 6 and 7, 88 Goulburn Street (Courtrooms only), and
- Law Courts Building at Queens Square (Registry only).

All general federal law cases for the Federal Magistrates Court are listed for hearing at John Maddison Tower.

The Queens Square location is for registry services only.

Enquiries and filing

All enquiries and filing of documents for the Federal Magistrates Court must take place at the Registry of the Law Courts Building at Queens Square (level 17). The Registry's telephone number is **02 9230 8567**. From 12 October 2009, there will be no registry or filing facilities at John Maddison Tower.

Where is John Maddison Tower?

The John Maddison Tower building is located at 88 Goulburn Street, between Castlereagh and Elizabeth Streets, Sydney.

Where is the Law Courts Building, Queens Square?

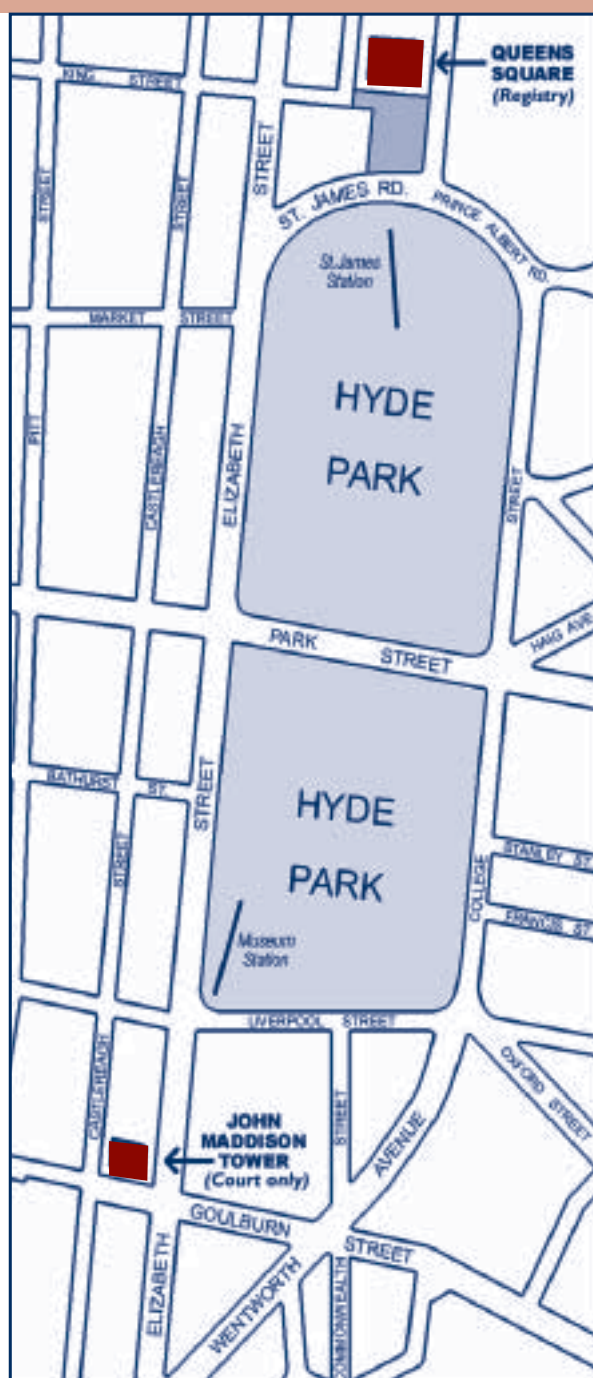
The registry for all enquiries is located on level 17 of the Law Courts Building at 237 Macquarie Street, Sydney. There are entrances to the building on Phillip Street, Macquarie Street and on Queens Square.

Wrong court location

If you mistakenly arrive at Queens Square for your case, you must notify court staff immediately. You will be asked by court staff to make your way to John Maddison Tower where all Federal Magistrates Court cases are listed for hearing.

Court staff will inform the other court location of your appearance and that you are making your way to the correct court location.

How to get to John Maddison Tower?

By train

There are three train stations within walking distance of John Maddison Tower. Museum station on the corner of Elizabeth and Liverpool Streets is the nearest stop with Town Hall and Central stations approximately 10 minutes walk away.

By bus

There are a number of bus routes that stop near John Maddison Tower. The right bus route will depend on your starting point. To find the most suitable bus route call the Transport InfoLine on **131 500** or go to www.131500.com.au

By car

A car park is situated directly opposite John Maddison Tower. The entry is in Goulburn Street close to the corner of Castlereagh Street.

By foot

From Queens Square to John Maddison Tower – Walk across both sections of Hyde Park to Liverpool Street and continue down Elizabeth Street to Goulburn Street (approximately 15 minutes).

How to get to the Law Courts Building in Queens Square?

By train

There are two train stations within walking distance of the Queens Square Law Courts Building. St James station on the Corner of Macquarie Street - please take the Macquarie Street exit which will bring you directly out on to Queens Square.

Martin Place station.

Please take the Phillip Street exit turning left and walking toward the corner of Phillip and King Streets. Martin Place Station is approximately 3 minutes walk away.

By bus

There are a number of bus routes that stop near Queens Square. The right bus route will depend on your starting point. To find the most suitable bus route call the Transport InfoLine on **131 500** or go to www.131500.com.au

By car

The nearest car park is situated next to the NSW Leagues Club on Elizabeth Street, near the corner of King Street.

By foot

From John Maddison Tower to Queens Square - Walk across both sections of Hyde Park to Macquarie Street (approximately 15 minutes).
